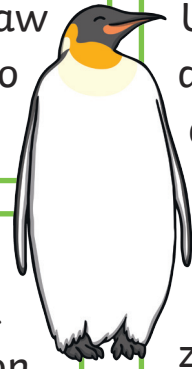


Zoo-Themed

Home Learning Challenges

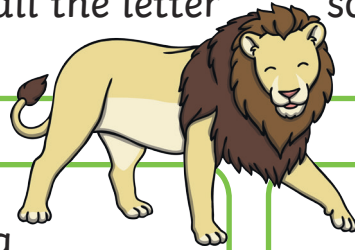
What is your favourite zoo animal? Draw or paint a picture of your favourite zoo animal. Can you write its name too?



Use some small animal toys to make a pretend zoo. What do you need to do to look after the animals in your zoo? What food would they eat? Have they got somewhere to sleep? What else would the animals need to be happy?

Ask a grown up to help you find out a fact about your favourite zoo animal. You could use the Internet or some non-fiction books to find some information. Maybe you could find out where your animal lives in the wild, what their babies are called or what they like to eat. Write your favourite fact to share with your friends.

Write a list of animals you would like to see in a zoo. Sound out the words carefully and try to write all the letter sounds you can hear. Can you write a list of 5 animals?



There are 6 penguins in a pool and 6 more penguins on their pebble nests. How many penguins are there altogether? Try drawing a picture to help you work out the answer.

Make a model of a zoo animal. You could use empty packaging, construction toys, playdough or paper. Think about the colours and shapes you need and how to join the pieces together.
